

Ontelaunee Jr Rifle Report

The air rifle team of Sarah Frantz, Kaitlyn Frantz, Calista Smoyer, Megan Waidelich, and Brenton Riegel have returned from the 3-P National Matches in Anniston, Alabama. On the first day of competition Calista finished 16th out of 200 competitors. Her score of 588, 43x won 1st place sub-junior and a Gold medal. Sarah also had a good day with a 5th place in the sub-junior class. Kaitlyn fired a personal best on day 1 and Megan a personal best on day 2. Our team placement in the National Jr Olympic 3-P Air Championship was 22nd, and for the CMP National Championship we were 25th.

Megan traveled from Anniston to Fort Benning, Georgia where she joined Amy Fister for the USA Shooting Nationals. They competed in woman's International Air Rifle, Smallbore Prone, and Smallbore 3-Position. Amy made it into the woman's Jr 3-P final and finished in 8th position.

On June 27th, we hosted an NRA 3-P Regional match at North End and Calista won the Sharpshooter/Marksman class. Attendance was low because many of our local competitors were at the USA Nationals.

On June 28th, Jenn Plocinik competed in an NRA 3-P match held in New Jersey. She out shot the other competitors and won the match.

Calista and Sarah are currently in Bristol, Indiana for the NRA National Smallbore Championships. They will be competing in the Metric Smallbore 3-P and the Conventional Smallbore 3-P.

Jenn is currently at Camp Perry, Ohio for the NRA 3-P training camp.
