Tonight, our team is at Guthsville competing in the prone league's last indoor match of the season.

We hosted the NRA 4-Position and 3-Position Jr Sectionals last month. There were a total of 26 juniors for the 4-P and 36 for the 3-P. Our juniors shot very well in both matches. Madilyn Riegel won the 4-P with a fabulous score of 398, 33x out of a possible 400, 40x. Since these sectionals will rank competitors nationally, it's no doubt Madilyn's score will be up around the top. Team members Madilyn, Sarah, Emma, and Calista won the 4-P team event with a score of 1574, 108x. In the 3-P match it was Madilyn again taking the gold with a great score of 578 out of 600. In fact, with Ontelaunee juniors taking the top 5 places, they secured the gold, silver, and bronze medals. The same team members mentioned earlier, also won the 3-P team match with a score of 2277. Congratulation to Sydney Utt for making this 3-P sectional her very first position match.

The Southeastern Air Rifle League ended its season at Palmyra and was shot on electronic targets. This match concluded with a final shoot off of the top 8 competitors, to determine rankings. Calista and Jeanne qualified into the final, where they took turns at the lead. After all the elimination shots were taken, they would finish 2nd & 3rd.

This past Friday's 3-P league was held at Columbia Fish & Game. Calista was our top shooter with a new personal best score of 578. One of our new juniors, Lizzie Cacace, traveled along with the team to make this her first position match.
