

Ontelaunee Jr Rifle Report

We had 6 juniors travel to Camp Perry, Ohio, to compete in the CMP National 3-Position Air Rifle Match. Out of a field of 55 teams, Ontelaunee placed 17th on day one and 23rd on day two. Sarah had a great match on day two, scoring a 591 out of a possible 600. She made it into the final shoot off and finished in 8th place.

Less than two weeks after returning from Ohio, Calista traveled to Colorado to participate in the American Legion National Air Rifle Championship. This was her second time earning an invitation for this match. After 2 days of shooting, 4 matches total, her final placement was 11th.

Jeanne represented Ontelaunee at the Keystone Games, held at Wilkes-Barre Gun Club. She competed in the outdoor 3-position smallbore match, and had a great score of 595 out of 600. This was plenty high enough to win the match and the gold medal.

Cecelia has been very proactive in looking at various colleges. Earlier this month she participated in a rifle clinic at the University of Memphis, which included a college tour. While only about an hour away, she included a visit to the University of Mississippi. Last month she visited the University of Nebraska Lincoln.

Later this month Emma will be at the West Virginia University for their annual rifle camp.
